**Submission of the
Alberta College of Medical Diagnostic and Therapeutic Technologists' (ACMDTT) Annual Report**

The Council and staff of the ACMDTT are pleased to acknowledge another successful year of ensuring that the public of Alberta are protected through the provision of safe, ethical and competent care, assured through regulation of the professions that fall within the ACMDTT.

There are over 2,300 extremely competent, skilled and patient-centered professionals regulated by the ACMDTT including radiological technologists, radiation therapists, nuclear medicine technologists, magnetic resonance technologists and electroneurophysiology technologists.

Since its inception as a health regulator in 2005, the College's mission articulates the purpose and mandate under which the College operates. The ACMDTT exists so that the public is assured of receiving safe, competent and ethical diagnostic and therapeutic care by a regulated and continually advancing profession. This Annual Report was developed and approved under the direction of the Council and CEO (Interim) of the ACMDTT. All numerical information is reported as of December 31, 2017.

Throughout 2017, we have also prepared for the regulation of diagnostic medical sonographers (DMS). Over 900 DMS voluntarily rostered with the College, offering the opportunity to optimize continuity of services provided to protect Albertans when the regulation of sonographers begins.

This Annual Report is a demonstration of our continued progress towards a responsible, profession-based regulation. We request that in accordance with Section 4 of the *Health Professions Act*, a copy of the report be brought before the Legislative Assembly.
