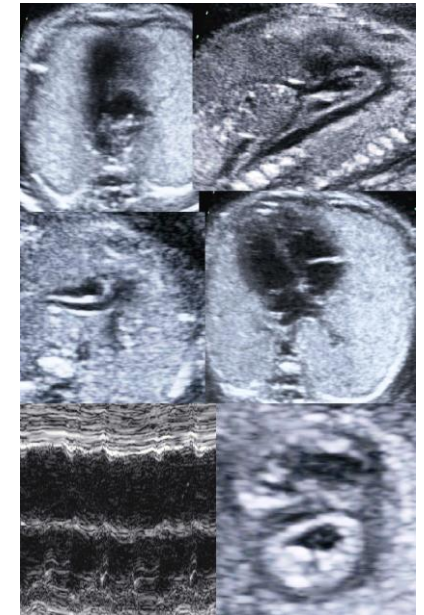

- How to obtain and interpret standard views of the fetal heart
- Congenital heart disease: abnormalities of chamber size, valve disease, great vessel abnormalities (including vascular rings)

- The basics of assessing fetal heart function and heart rhythm
