- Instructs patients on examination requested.
- Assist in the instruction of new staff as requested by DI supervisor. Attention to procedures and department orientation.

- Willing to assist Radiologist or fellow staff members
- Replenish inventory supplies in rooms
- Responsible for general patient care and safety
- Notify DI supervisor of inadequate inventory, equipment problems or any problems encountered during your shift.
- Must maintain the utmost in professional confidence of patient information and/or results
- Cross trained in BD, Fluoroscopy and ECG's
